We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Stoney Creek Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Stoney Creek continuously works to improve all aspects of the educational process. Our focus continues to be on Math and ELA. We have also included professional development regarding the whole child and trauma informed practices. We continue to implement PBIS for all students and staff. School Placement (Stoney Creek grades K-2)

All students entering K-2 will go into their respective grade based on age and/or grade level completion. Students are assessed to determine added intervention needs and then placed into additional assistance programs within the grade structure.

School Improvement

Stoney Creek worked collaboratively with their building School Improvement Teams, consideration was given to the most current research and best practices with respect to various curricular areas, the delivery of instruction and the method of evaluation. Our team currently has two parents actively represented on our teams. The District School Improvement Committee as well as the individual Building School Improvement teams has played an important role in developing the District School Improvement plan. We are confident that by continuing to work through our school improvement process, Comstock Park will improve in its mission of success for all.
