What is 98c

98c is federal funds to address learning loss as part of the Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund and part of the federal Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) II Fund.

Funding Amount

- Based on number of districts that apply
 - Estimated funding at \$50 per student
 - Use of funding to occur during the 22-23 school year
 - Deadline to apply is November 30th
 - Funds available in early December

- Whole Child
- Culture and Climate
- Community Engagement

Funding Initiatives

- Intervention Staff/Support for ELA and/or Math

- Surveys
- Parent Participation
